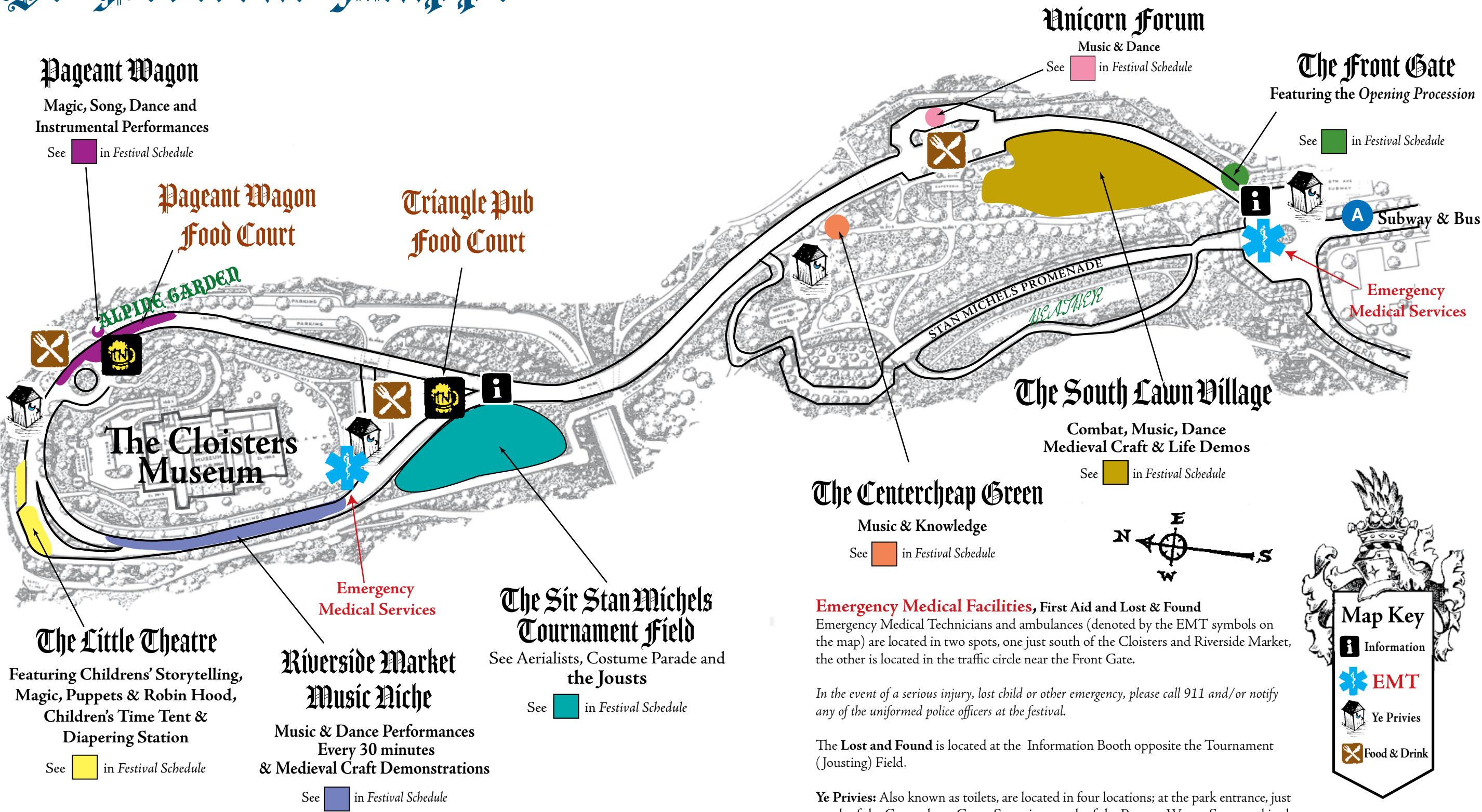

Emergency Medical Facilities, First Aid and Lost & Found

Ye Privies: Also known as toilets, are located in four locations; at the park entrance, just north of the Centercheap Green Stage, just north of the Pageant Wagon Stage, and in the parking area south of the Cloisters Museum, (between the Tournament Field and Riverside Market)

Food And Drink: There are three food areas—the first is in the Centercheap, opposite the Unicorn Forum, the second is just south of the Pageant Wagon, and the third is the Triangle Pub, located opposite the tournament field.
